Financial Report: Jan, 2023 balance **\$2800.00** (transfer from Anita Evans to JoAnn Stanford Sep 30, 2023 balance **\$2830.00** I recommend that balance be no lower than **\$2,000.00**, and I notify officers. Propane costs to heat during the winter are much higher

Secretary Report: 2023 active members are 50 and 5 of them are Provisional. Provisional pay \$10.00 and only to NHPA. They must be a full member in the future. Income is down due to less entries per tournament and less members. WE have lost 10+ members for years now. Fourteen members from 2022 have not renewed this year. There will be no winter sanctioned tournaments at Crossville for 2024 and a decision will need to be made re: Rutledge Practices and tournaments.

Election of Officers: President= Alan Pepper 2nd Vice President Merle South. There were no nominations from the floor. Both reelected by Acclimation. This is for 2 year terms. Alan pepper was filling an emergency for 1 year.

New Business: proposals for vote:

1. Proposal to make first tie breaker in all non -handicap tournaments to be Head to Head. Proposal dropped because covered by NHPA rules that tournament director decides and notifies entries of method being used. 3 choices are ringer percentage, head to head or total points. **Proposal removed.**

- 2. Tournament directors discontinue having 2 person classes, add another class and then handicap.
 Failed yes = 12 No =- 14 Failed
- **3**. Reduce Tournament Fee from \$25 to \$20. Reduce Tournament Director from \$6.00 tO \$1.00 payout To winners will remain the same. YES = 2 NO = 10 **Failed**
- Change state Singles Tournament from last Saturday in September to the week after Labor Day.
 Yes =- 9 No 14 Failed

5. Change to Tournament Payout: leave entry fee at \$25.00 reduce tournament directors to \$4.00 and increase TNHPA allotment to \$3.00. This will help to increase the bank account. **Passed = 17**
